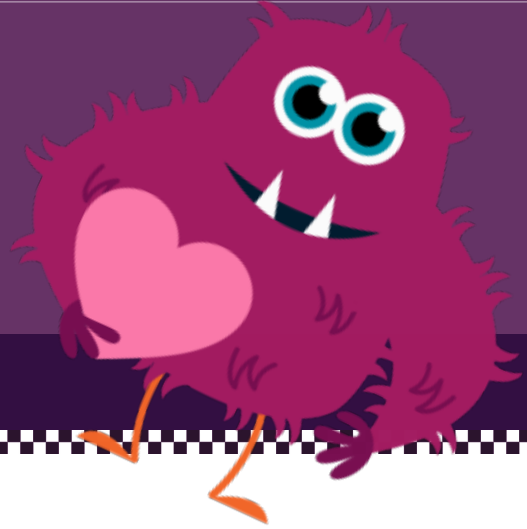


Mrs. Hoppins and Mr. Fullarton

Science:

Students are excited about our unit: Boats and Buoyancy. Key vocabulary in this unit includes: waterproof, buoyancy, stability and load.
